

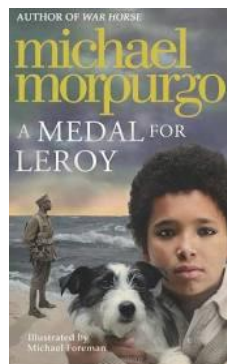


English

Mental Maths Focus

- Recall multiples of **all times tables** in any order up to 12 x 12 with related division facts with growing fluency

History

Children will begin their topic by locating, identifying and ordering the main events of World War I and World War II.

They will then learn, in chronological order, how the two conflicts began and the effects they had on people. Children, through drama, writing and debating, will be able to empathise with different people of those eras – including the main leaders, soldiers and civilians.
