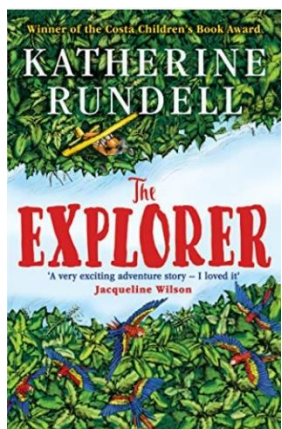


English

To support our English teaching and learning we will be using the following book: The Explorer by Katherine Rundell

Along with our theme learning these will help us create the following writing outcomes:

- Adventure Story
- Non-Chronological Report



Maths

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Investigations applying number and four operation understanding

Mental Maths Focus

- Recall multiples of 12 in any order and related division facts including missing numbers
- Recall multiples of **all times tables** in any order up to 12 x 12 with related division facts with growing fluency

Geography

Children will begin the theme by learning what is meant by a biome. This will lead to an in depth study of rainforests, exploring their location around the world through the use of globes and atlases. They will use geographical language to explain why they are located where they are.



Children will explore the layers of the rainforest and the specific vegetation that resides in each layer.

Settlement and land use within the rainforest will also be researched.

Science

In Science, the children will learn to classify animals into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals. They will identify how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment and that adaptations lead to evolution.
